An appointment is required!

This service is first and foremost offered to passport applicants for whom a visit to one of the designated offices is particularly burdensome due to physical, medical or other urgent reasons (e.g. elderly or disabled people, families with children). Secondly, this service will be offered to other passport applicants in the area.

You are strongly advised to read and follow these instructions carefully and in their entirety!

- Please keep in mind that incomplete applications will not be accepted!
- Each applicant will be required to appear in person, including children, regardless of their age.
- Our back office in the Netherlands may request additional information and/or documents for clarification, if necessary.
- Please keep in mind that all fees paid are non-refundable and only USD Credit and Debit cards (Visa or MasterCard) are accepted.

Scheduling your appointment:

Please be aware that our appointment system only allows 1 applicant per 20 minute appointment slot. To schedule an appointment please follow these steps:

- Select "San Francisco"
- Select "**Travel document at a location other than the Embassy**"
- Select, your day and time slot and confirm

We kindly ask you to not unnecessarily occupy appointment slots and cancel your appointment if you are not able to make it as a courtesy to others!
